- The fresher candidates have to enroll themselves at the approved training centers to complete entire training program. After completion of training, they will be eligible to appear for Assessment.
- Testing centre selection depends on the experts from head office, An industrial partner may be choose for testing centre, however in case of minimum twenty candidates in a batch and there is no any feasibility, the training centre may be selected as testing centre.
